Free to income eligible pregnant women and children aged birth - 3

Weekly in-home visits

Health & Developmental screenings for children and pregnant women

Bi-monthly socializations

Provides parenting, health and safety education

Provides referrals to local resources



What is a Home Visit?

Your Home Visitor will bring fun and developmentally appropriate activities to your home weekly.

Screenings for Hearing, Vision, Development and Social-Emotional Skills will be provided.

Your Home Visitor will help you navigate parenting and other needs that may arise with your child and family.



What is Socialization?

Socialization provides opportunities for families to enjoy educational and fun activities in our family friendly group setting. Parents can connect with other parents. Children get to learn from other children and work on new skills together. It's a great time for everyone!
